As nature winds down into fall, we at Holy Family are ramping up our efforts to maintain our various sites. This spring, we were forced to delay many needed projects because of the COVID-19 pandemic; but as our office reopened, we returned to our to-do list, and addressed issues at our churches. Thus far, we have completed multiple projects, and continue to work on others.

Workers are tuckpointing St. Peter Church as well as laying down a new roof, and recently painted the shed. At Our Risen Savior, the garage has a new roof, and the church is getting new windows. In the cemetery, parishioners will soon see a beautiful new sign and flag pole as a result of a generous donation. Our team is working to repair a leak at Presentation, which once fixed, will allow us to repaint. Holy Family Hall is being painted, along with several other areas of the Parish Office, and the Sacred Heart site had a "water way" installed to help alleviate water issues. At St. Mary Church, the remodeling of the lower level restrooms was completed, and we are currently working to close the tunnel in the basement which once connected the church to the school.
