### **Explanation of Calendar**

#### -ALL Candidates

- Parent Meeting: Attend either option 1 or 2; Parents & candidates attend.
- **Sponsor/Candidate Meeting:** Attend either option 1 or 2; Sponsors & candidates attend; If sponsor lives out of town, a parent can attend in their place & relay relevant information.
- **Confirmation Rehearsal:** Attend the rehearsal that is the night before your selected Confirmation Liturgy; Sponsors & candidates attend; A parent CANNOT fill in for the sponsor on this night.
- **Confirmation Liturgy:** Attend the liturgy you signed up for upon registration; The last date to change your liturgy is March 1st; Sponsors & Candidates sit together in reserved pews, while the rest of family sits in unreserved seating.
- Graduation Mass & Mystagogy: Parents & candidates attend a Mass & brief meeting at Holy Family Church to reflect on the year in formation.


-ALL Candidate/Sponsor To-Dos: Sponsors & Candidates should meet monthly so that sponsors can adequately & actively mentor candidates over the course of the year. These activities can be done ANY TIME during the month, but should be completed by the last day of each month.

- August Deadline to Select Sponsor (STRICTLY REQUIRED): A person who is serving as a
  confirmation sponsor must: be designated by the one to be confirmed; be 16 years
  old; be a Catholic who has been confirmed and who has received the sacrament of
  Eucharist and leads a life in harmony with the faith and role to be undertaken; not be
  bound by any canonical penalty legitimately imposed or declared; not be the father
  or mother of the one to be confirmed.
- September Select a Prayer for the Year: Sponsors/Candidates should meet or call to discuss a prayer that they can both pray throughout the year as the candidate prepares for Confirmation.
- October Sponsor's Choice: Sponsor should select a prayer activity or practice to be undertaken with their candidate this month.
- November Select Saint (Confirmation) Name (STRICTLY REQUIRED): Sponsors should help candidates select their saint (confirmation name).
- December Volunteer for Advent: Sponsors/Candidates should find some kind of service in the month of December to complete together.
- January Attend Mass Together: Sponsors/Candidates should attend Mass together this month.
- <u>February Confirmation Questionnaire (STRICTLY REQUIRED):</u> Sponsors should check in & make sure their candidate has completed the Confirmation Questionnaire, which will serve as their formal request to the Bishop to receive the sacrament of Confirmation.
- March Joint Lenten Commitment: Sponsors/candidates should select a small practice they can undertake together during the season of Lent.
- April Candidate's Choice: Candidate should select a prayer activity or practice to be undertaken with their sponsor this month.

• **4 Sunday Meetings:** 10am Mass at Holy Family (<u>parents attend with candidates</u>); Lunch (provided); 2 Speakers; 2 Small Group periods; Adoration/Confession; Concludes at 2pm.

- 1 Retreat: Arrive at 6pm on Friday night at Saint Mary's Springs, South Parking Lot; sleep over on Friday night, bring a sleeping bag & pillow; bring Bible, Rosary, Journal, & comfy clothes / toiletries for Saturday. Head home at 10pm on Saturday night. Attend Mass at 10am at Holy Family Church on Sunday; retreat concludes when Mass does (around 11am). (Updated 10/11/21)
- Letters of Encouragement: These are letters from Catholic relatives and important faith figures in the candidate's life. Parents, grandparents, godparents, sponsors, aunts/uncles, older siblings, or any person who has a relationship with the candidate who would like to send them a word of encouragement regarding their confirmation is invited to write a letter. The letters are comprised of whatever words of encouragement or wisdom you feel called to share with the candidate. In their faith journey, this is a landmark moment that notes their full acceptance into the Catholic Faith



and their full acceptance of that faith. Write a letter that will make them feel special, supported, and strengthened. Let them know you are proud of them. It can be as long or short as you'd like (a brief personal message can go a long way), but they typically range from ½ page to 2 pages. They are due back to the coordinator 2 weeks before Confirmation retreat.

-ONLY Public-School Candidates: These events are part of Public-School students' ongoing formation, as requested by the Archdiocese of Milwaukee.

- Parent/Student Night Mental Health Seminar: Parents & Candidates attend a seminar from 4-6pm at Sacred Heart on mental health.
- **Thanksgiving Service:** Candidates only attend a special Thanksgiving service from 4-6pm at Sacred Heart.
- Parent/Student Night Advent Service: Parents & Candidates attend a special service for Advent from 4-6pm at Sacred Heart.
- **Safeguarding Lessons & Drills:** Candidates attend a special seminar on safe-guarding from 4-5pm at Sacred Heart.
- At-Home Service Weekend: Parents & Candidates take time to do some kind of service for the local community.
- **Parish Mission:** Parents & Candidates attend Holy Family's annual parish mission; attend at least one of the three nights.
- Annual Lenten Practices & Stations: Parents & Candidates attend a Lenten prayer service at Holy Family.
- **Shrine Field Trip:** Candidates bus from Sacred Heart to Our Lady of Guadalupe Shrine in LaCrosse. Bus departs at 8am & returns at 6pm. Mass will be celebrated on the trip.

#### **Attendance Policies**

## -ONLY Session A -ONLY SESSION B -ONLY SESSION C

- IMPORTANT: the priest team has approved this abbreviated program only under the stipulation that candidates attend ALL of the dates in their session. Absences are not excused, nor can they be made up at an additional event without the permission of a priest. If a candidate misses a Sunday meeting or a portion of their retreat, they will have to contact the coordinator (andrews@hffdl.org) to schedule a meeting with a priest. At this meeting, candidates can explain the circumstances surrounding their absence & request to continue in the sacramental program. If the priest deems the circumstances legitimate, the coordinator will assign a suitable make-up event. If the priest does not deem the circumstances legitimate, and denies the request for continuation in the sacramental program, then candidates can reapply for Confirmation the following year.
- RECOMMENDATION: <u>as soon as</u> candidates select a session, they should clear their extracurricular, athletic, and work schedules for those dates.

### -ONLY Public-School Candidates:

- Candidates are allowed three absences without penalty. Please notify the coordinator
  of an absence in advance by filling out the Absence Form on the HS Formation
  Webpage.
- Any additional absences should be made up; candidates can make these up by attending Cor Jesu or Youth Group on Thursday nights. A full schedule of these makeups is available on the HS Formation Webpage.
