Taste of India: Father Thomas shared information about his homeland of India. Tom Endejan and Brian Carter cooked up some delicious Indian food for all to share.



Thank You to all our parishioners who contribute regularly and to special requests or projects. Financially, in fiscal year 2016-2017:

- \Rightarrow Contributions were down by \$68,000 or 2.4%.
- \Rightarrow Expenses were \$228,000 less that the previous year.
- \Rightarrow Expense control continues to be a major focus.
- \Rightarrow The revenue and expense budget for the current fiscal year was decreased by \$150,000.
- \Rightarrow The debt was eliminated with proceeds from the school sale.
- \Rightarrow The sale of St. Mary and St. Joseph Schools was closed in January of 2017
