A letter from your Holy Family Priest | Requests for additions to Mass Schedule

Over the last few months I've gotten a number of requests to return to our "pre-COVID' mass schedule. While I certainly acknowledge that returning to a full slate of masses is desired by some, there are a number of things that need to be taken into consideration.

- 1. Prior to the COVID Pandemic in March of 2020, the Holy Family priests and staff met to discuss restructuring our Mass schedule to better serve our entire parish community. A new schedule was proposed and adopted by the Pastoral Council and was to be implemented in the summer of 2020. The new schedule approved by council is the schedule we have implemented during our return to Mass from the COVID Pandemic.
- 2. The pandemic has also impacted the arrival of our fifth priest, Fr. Alex, who is still awaiting his visa approval in Guatemala This process was delayed due to COVID and we hope to be able to expand our ministry efforts when he arrives.
- 3. The availability of "help out" priests is very limited. We are extremely thankful for all of the retired priests who have served our community. The new schedule approved by the Pastoral Council reduced the amount of help out priests recognizing that their availability is not guaranteed and the financial cost to our parish was significant.
- 4. Good Liturgies are not easy to plan. They involve priests, musicians, sacristans, ushers, greeters, communion distributers, and others to ensure that the Mass is celebrated well. Unfortunately, these volunteers, priests, and musicians are sometimes difficult to schedule. Fewer and fewer people are getting involved in the support of Mass and as a result, we cannot continue to offer the same amount of masses as we've done in the past.

We try to offer Masses to fit as many schedules as possible, but unfortunately, we cannot do so at the sites and times most convenient for all of our parishioners. As this is our current reality, I'd like to take a moment to encourage you to explore and visit other Holy Family Parish sites. Check out a different Mass and meet new people. Who knows, you might find something you really enjoy about the new church site! We are blessed to have six churches that offer a wide array of mass times on Saturday and Sunday for you to attend, and we are thankful for your continued support and prayers.


