

## Prayer and Worship: Art and Environment Committees

Gifts needed for this position:

Willingness to be part of a **team and work collaboratively. Creative** thinking is helpful, but it is more important to be willing to be open to new things. A familiarity with some tools, such as glue gun, scissors, small hand tools is helpful. Ability to climb ladder, some lifting and stairs (not all of the volunteers have to be able to do all these things, but some are needed. Some floral arranging skill is helpful and a good seamstress would be a nice addition.

## Description and Responsibilities of the position:

Help plan and implement environmental decorations for the various liturgical seasons, including Ordinary time, Advent, Christmas, Lent, Easter and special events that may occur throughout the year. Help keep the storage environmental supply storage areas organized.

Be aware of the church and liturgical environment and advise of things that need attention .

## Time Commitment:

The Advent, Christmas, Lent and Easter seasons require the most time commitment and the timing is based upon the calendar (example: Christmas decorations can't be completed until after the last Sunday of Advent, but some minor preparations can be put in place ahead of that time).

Time commitment ranges from 2-4 hours at any given time. "Un-decorating" is as important as the decorating, and also must be accomplished on a timely basis. The Co-ordinators make every effort to set the work times to be convenient for as many Committee members as possible
