**THE LITTLE ROSARY

The first time we say once *Our Father, etc.*, and five times *Hail Mary, etc.*, in honor of Jesus; the second time in honor of Mary, and the third time in honor of St. Anne, and repeat after each *Hail Mary* the three names of *Jesus, Mary, Anne*. Grant me the favour I ask—
