Holy Family Catholic Community offers "Christ is Risen" Scholarship

Holy Family Catholic Community will award two \$500 scholarships to students who, along with their parents, have been registered members of Holy Family Catholic Community for at least one year prior to applying for the scholarship. Students must have received the Sacrament of Confirmation to be eligible to apply.
