

2021-2022 First Reconciliation & First Communion Sacramental Calendar



The Sacrament Program is a home based study designed for you and your child(ren) to learn the teaching of the Catholic Church on the Sacraments of First Reconciliation and First Communion.

There will be 2 meetings leading up to First Reconciliation and 1 meeting leading up to First Communion that will consist of Mass and a brief meeting. There will be 2 options for each of these meetings that a parent and the communicant are expected to attend. Then there is a meeting leading up to each of the Sacraments for the parents only.

In addition there will be a retreat, called Jesus Day, leading up to First Communion. Again there will be 2 dates to choose from and a parent is expected to attend with the communicant.
