Old Business

- **Rectory Committee Update**

Letters going out to about 300 of our high-level donors with brochure
Committee will follow up with phone calls
Plan to go public to entire parish May-June
\$550,000 has been pledged or raised so far
Finance Council has approved moneys from sale of all rectories to be set aside for the rectory
Goal is to raise \$300,000 - \$500,00 from general parish
Hope to break ground in early November

- **Parish Missions – Fr. John Burns/Katie Patrizio**

Many positive comments about both missions: Katie Patrizio – Very energetic presentation and excellent presentation of covenantal relationship
Fr. Burns – parishioners grateful for live streaming

- **VUCA**

Fr. Edward had a presentation on VUCA, which means a Volatile, Uncertain, Complex and Ambiguous world. He explained how to cope with that world according to the gospel. Many positive comments.

New Business

- **Parish Council Recruitment Subcommittee**

Seven present council members have agreed to another 3-year term
Two members are still discerning
We will need 4-6 new members

- **Covid Policy Changes – Parish Feedback**

Fond du lac Health Department has approved 75% capacity in public places
