A letter from your Holy Family priest | Progress continues on Rectory Campaign

Dear Holy Family Catholic Community Parishioner(s),

As October winds down, we are happy to say that progress on our future Holy Family rectory is picking up steam!

Recently, we learned that the closing date on the rectory has moved up from November 5th to November 1st. This will allow us to begin our renovation work sooner, and get our priest team into their new home hopefully even faster than we anticipated. To do this work, members of our Rectory Committee met with two local contractors who expressed interest in bidding on the project at the rectory. We currently are awaiting their bids and once we receive them, our Rectory Committee will meet to discuss options.

Thanks to the generous donations of parishioners like yourselves, this month we also crossed a new milestone in our fundraising campaign. Between donations pledged and received, as well as the proceeds of property sales, we have raised \$1,814,641 to buy and renovate our new rectory. This is amazing progress, but we still have \$185,359 to raise before we reach our goal.

With only a few days left in our campaign, I ask that you consider donating and help us close this final gap. If you have already given, I ask you to consider making another sacrificial gift. Our new rectory not only comes with opportunities for growth, development, and flexibility for our parish, but it also offers our priest team a place of rest, community, and care for our spiritual and mental wellbeing.
