A letter from your Holy Family priest | What we can learn from "Dorf Kapelle"

Holy Family Oktoberfest is here! The Mass, a German folk band, bratwursts, and Friedrich the Oktoberfest Squirrel – what else could you need?

Tamales, you say? Well, we have those too.

One of the fun features of this Oktoberfest will be the presence of the German folk band *Dorf Kapelle*. I don't speak German, but the Internet tells me that *Dorf* means "village," while *Kapelle* actually has two meanings: either "band" or "chapel."

We don't think of chapels as very similar to folk bands. But the image of a folk band does reflect our vocation as the Church in several ways.

First, what musician doesn't learn the music and **follow the instructions of the conductor**? Each of us is called to learn about the teachings of our Faith, and to listen to Our Lord in prayer.

Second, musicians play a variety of different roles, and each musician must play his particular instrument. All of us, as Christians, have different missions in the Church. We need to discern how God has called us, and what spiritual gifts or "charisms" He has given us. This takes reflection, prayer, and experimentation. Have you discerned the gifts God has given you? What is your mission in the Church?

Finally, a musician **has to actually play**! He cannot just sit on the sidelines and imagine the music. He has to practice and make mistakes and actually perform in the presence of others. We as Catholics have to live our faith in action. This means service, it means telling the stories of our faith, it means living with abandon the vocation God has given you.

Dorf Kapelle is a community of musicians, united by their knowledge and expertise in playing "Roll Out the Barrel" and other authentic German folk songs. The Church is a community of believers in Christ, united by the Holy Spirit and existing to the glory of God the Father. Are we listening to Christ, living generously our particular mission in the Church, and harmonizing together to the praise of God?

"Sing to the LORD a new song, for he has done marvelous things... make music to the LORD with the harp, with the harp and the sound of singing, with trumpets and the blast of the ram's horn— shout for joy before the LORD, the King" (Psalm 98:1, 5-6).
