A letter from your Holy Family priest | Hello from Fr. Alejandro!

Hello,

I am Fr. Alejandro Umul from Guatemala. I belong to the Missionary Fraternity of Mary.

I want to share with you my experience of my vocation to become a priest. When I was 7 years old, I received my first holy communion and became an altar server. Since that day I became close to the priest, and of course, to Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament. I was enjoying going to church every Sunday, I could not miss any service. When I was 14 years old, lay missionaries came to my village for Holy Week. Every day they visited the families, and in the evening, met with various groups for catechesis or formation. My house was very small, but we hosted 3 of them. Their testimony inspired me to become a missionary.

When I finished secondary school, I decided that I had to look for an institution where they formed missionaries. A friend from secondary school talked to me about the Missionary Fraternity of Mary, how the seminarians go every weekend to various villages to work and evangelize the people. I went to find out information, and I was given a schedule of vocational retreats, and the retreat of admission. I participated in all of them and finally I was admitted.

I started my formation in 1996. I was excited to go for my first missionary experience. I was sent to a village where travelling included walking for one hour. It was a small village in the south of Guatemala. Every Saturday we could visit families, sharing meals with them. In the evenings, we met the children, then the youth, and finally we had the Liturgy of the Word with the whole community. On Sundays, we visited a couple of families, had catechesis with the children, and at noon we were ready to walk one hour downhill to wait for the bus back to the seminary.

I enjoyed my formation in the classrooms, but I believe that the power that was attracting me to become a priest was the missionary life, the experience of working and sharing with the people.
