A letter from your Holy Family priest | "The end is worth the effort – an eternity with God"

The readings for Lent's first Sunday demonstrate for us the ways in which God intervenes in the life of his chosen people. In offering the first fruits of his harvest, the believer calls himself a wandering Aramean. This is a direct reference to Abraham the nomad, who answers God's calling, becoming the first in a long line of patriarchs. He and his flock follow Yahweh. He becomes their God, and they become His chosen people. They have a route, and God will lead them to the promised land.

Gratitude is in the heart and on the mind of this Hebrew farmer as he presents this offering in the holy sanctuary. He offers not just for himself, but for those who helped make his harvest a success: God, laborers, immigrants, and believers alike.

Paul's words in our second reading sets the stage for today's Gospel which documents the showdown between Jesus, the son of God, and the devil, the damned of God. Paul explains that confessing Jesus is done by mouth and with belief in the heart. The place of Jesus in our spiritual life is of the utmost importance. Meeting Jesus, his nemesis, the devil's goal is to get back at God for his banishment. The devil knows that Jesus is God's son and that to conquer Jesus is a defeat for God.

The confrontation rages with a weakened Jesus clashing with a confident Satan. As with Adam and Eve, Satan sweet-talks Jesus, yet each time Jesus repeals the devil's advances. His love for God, his father, and his desire to do his father's will are too strong to overwhelm him. Jesus stands his ground and defeats God's enemy.

As we stand at the beginning of Lent, we are all faced with this great showdown between good and evil. The defeat of Satan at the hands of Jesus only left the evil one more emboldened to get even with God. Today believers know that while they may fail, Jesus does not. If we accept Jesus making the necessary changes in our hearts and in our daily lives, we, his followers, have a good chance of surviving Satan's prompts. It may mean altering aspects of our lives but the end is worth the effort – an eternity with God.
