A letter from your Holy Family Priest | The importance of a name

In today's readings we come across many names. There is, of course, the name of Jesus, the name that the apostles preached as risen from the dead. But we hear many other names in the readings of this week. Saint Peter appears twice, in the first reading and the Gospel. We heard Saint John give his name at the beginning of the second reading and is one of the "sons of Zebedee" mentioned in the Gospel. The names of Thomas and Nathanael make an appearance in the Gospel as well.

Names, i.e. concrete individuals, are part and parcel of the Christian life and the life of the Church. We encounter this phenomenon throughout the Mass. We often read the texts of named prophets such as Isaiah, Jeremiah, etc. Saint Paul, and not some anonymous apostle, usually supplies our second reading. Each Gospel is marked by the name of the Evangelist who wrote it. The 1st Eucharistic Prayer contains lists of names of the apostles (Peter and Paul, Andrew, James,), early martyrs of the Church (Ignatius, Alexander, Marcellinus,) and intentionally lists several women who witnessed to the faith (Felicity, Perpetua, Agatha, Lucy...).

The importance of the "name" in the life of the Church is not something to be overlooked. Jesus called His first disciples by name, He revealed to us that He knows us by name, especially by our Baptism. This is all to say that Christ's Church is not an abstract institution, but is made up of named individuals like you and me.
