Today on Palm Sunday we celebrate Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem. This entry represents both an end and a beginning. It represents an end to his ministry in Galilee and a beginning of his ministry on his way to Jerusalem. His controversial presence there will supply the religious leadership of his time with plenty of motivation to murder Jesus and trigger the unfolding of the Passion narrative.

The culmination of Jesus' journey centers around the demands of discipleship. From the very start of His journey, Jesus receives several excuses not to follow him – all of them very human – to which the Lord answers, "No one who sets a hand to the plow and looks to what is left behind is fit for the kingdom of God." Therefore, when Christ comes to Jerusalem, there is a kind of ritualization of discipleship itself because it is literally the crowning moment for Jesus and his followers.

In Luke's Gospel we read from today, Jesus is called "king" because his followers are in pursuit of the kingdom which Jesus will rule over. His followers proclaim "Blessed is the king who comes in the name of the Lord!" His followers prepare and proclaim – which is precisely what we should be doing as well, preparing and proclaiming.

The beginning of Holy Week calls our attention to follow the Lord from traveling to teaching, to passion to death and finally to resurrection. We must be ready for the long haul of Holy Week and avail ourselves as baptized Christians of the fullness of grace that is offered to us through in person worship. This Holy Week invites us to full and activate participation in the life of the Church and we should be willing to enter into it fully as well. So, when Jesus enters, we are fully committed to wave our branches publicly for our great King! Let us prepare to follow Jesus wherever he may lead us this week. Let us cherish our Lord throughout this most Holy Week and make a habit of it last a lifetime. Have a blessed Holy Week.
