### A letter from your Holy Family Priest | "Welcome the Stranger"

Dear Holy Family Catholic Community Parishioner(s),

In recent weeks, the Fond du Lac area has begun to welcome an increasing number of families seeking asylum, coming from throughout the world as they flee threats, violence, and persecution in their home countries.

Personally, I cannot imagine the fear one must experience when they are forced to leave their homeland, nor how it feels to have to rebuild your life in a place and in a culture that are new and unknown. Without a doubt, it is no easy journey to make, and asylum seekers continue to face challenges even once they reach safe land.

In order to help these families as they try to get their feet on the ground, Holy Family Catholic Community is providing them temporary respite housing at our unused rectories. To do so is both our privilege and our duty.

They have documentation from the Department of Homeland Security to stay and work in the United States and will be seeking jobs in the area. Just as you and I do, they want to contribute to the community.

As they settle here, let us keep in mind the words of God to the people of Israel, "Therefore love the stranger, for you were strangers in the land of Egypt," Deuteronomy 10:19. We all have the story of the immigrant in our blood, our ancestors making the voyage to the United States for the very same reason asylum seekers do today: to find a better life. As they begin their American story, we should do all we can to welcome them, love them, and help them as our faith and our common humanity call us to do.
