Clayton is a sweet boy who's 11 years old and was born with a rare chromosome disorder. He faces many medical challenges including seizures, dependence on oxygen, dystonia, and dysautonomia. He is globally delayed and requires full care. All of this is outweighed by the amount of love that Clay gives out. God surely knew that the world needed a bright light and he gave us Clay. In the past year, his ability to breathe, as well as regulate his body temperature and heart rate began to deteriorate, but with the help of new medicine he is now improving. Brothers and sisters in Christ,

“Prayer is only as good as the preparation for it.” This is what Romano Guardini, a 20th century priest and theologian who influenced Pope Benedict XVI and Pope Francis, wrote about prayer in *The Art of Praying*. Prayer depends on our preparation.

Next Sunday begins for us a season of preparation – a season of quiet, of discipline, of waiting for the Lord. It is also my favorite liturgical season: the season of Advent (named for the Latin adventus, meaning “arrival” or “coming”).

In Advent we prepare for the second coming of Christ as Lord, and we prepare to celebrate his first coming as a tiny newborn. In Advent we have more silence in the Mass; we forego the singing of the Gloria, because the Gloria is a Christmas song – the song of the angels.

We will listen each week to the prophecies of Isaiah, and will be forcefully called to repentance by John the Baptist. And the Lord’s command “stay awake!” of Advent’s first week becomes the quiet anticipation of the holy family awaiting the birth of the Christ Child. Christmas will only be as good as our preparation for it, to paraphrase Guardini. So, I invite you to take time to prepare for the Lord. Go to confession, read the Scripture readings before Mass, pause before a Nativity Scene and talk to God, or stop by the adoration chapel.
