

A letter from your Holy Family priest | A Reflection on Purgatory

Many people think that the purgatory does not exist. However, St. Paul tells us in Colossians 1:24 "I must complete what is lacking in the suffering of Christ." This means that something needs to be done by us. We truly believe that Christ merited our salvation on the Cross. Thus, we have been forgiven of our sins so we can avoid hell. That means that we are now redeemed. However, we should cooperate with that grace. Therefore, Sacred Scriptures say that nothing imperfect will enter in the Kingdom of God. In Revelation 21:27, we read "Nothing impure will ever enter in [Heaven], nor will anyone who does what is shameful or deceitful..."

Thus, we need to work to: a) Detach from current sin; b) Be purified from our own passion; c) Be prepared to meet God so we do not have sins.
