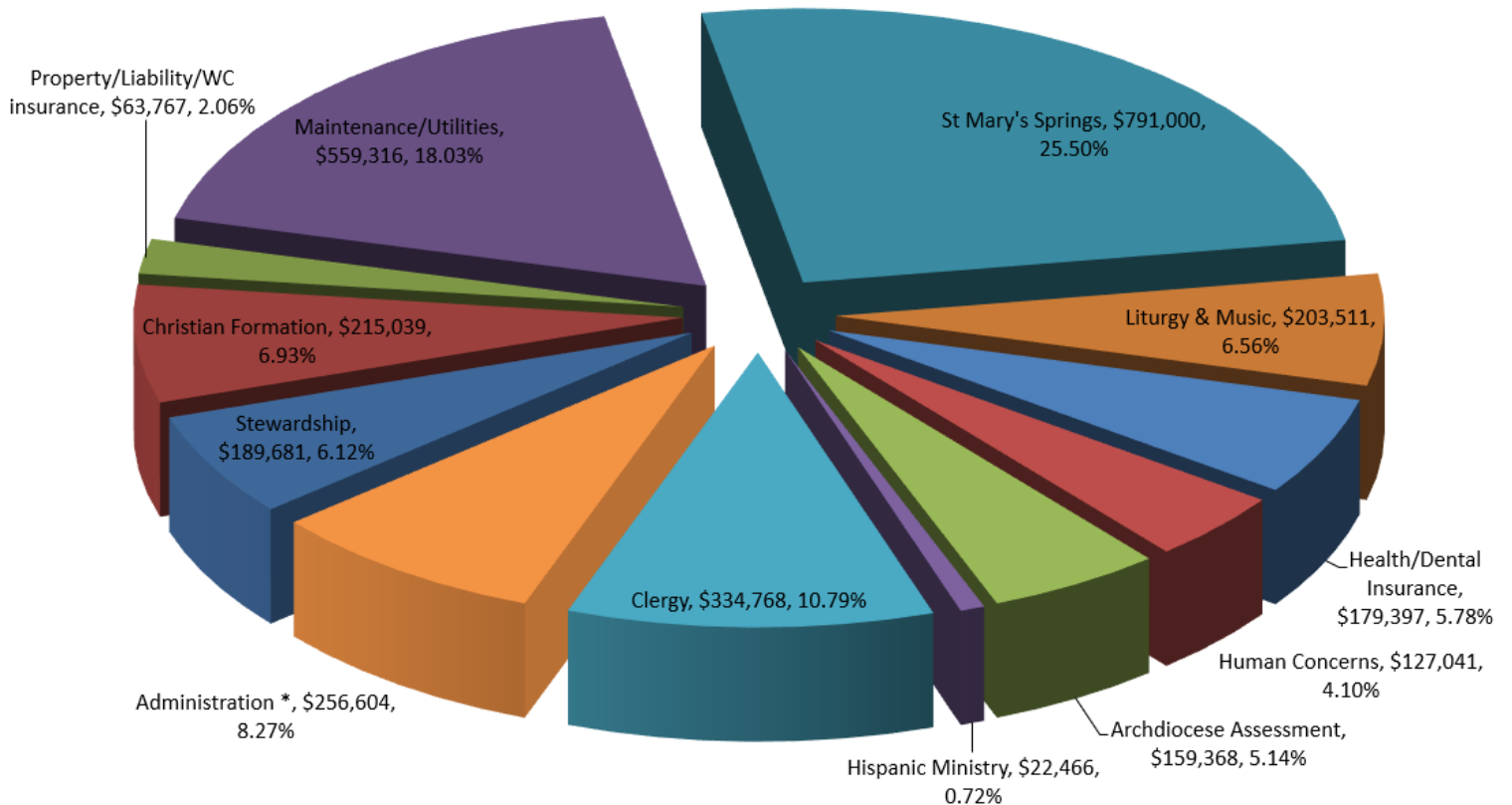

*A letter from your Holy Family priest | A Reflection on Purgatory*

Many people think that the purgatory does not exist. However, St. Paul tells us in Colossians 1:24 “I must complete what is lacking in the suffering of Christ.” This means that something needs to be done by us. We truly believe that Christ merited our salvation on the Cross. Thus, we have been forgiven of our sins so we can avoid hell. That means that we are now redeemed. However, we should cooperate with that grace. Therefore, Sacred Scriptures say that nothing imperfect will enter in the Kingdom of God. In Revelation 21:27, we read “Nothing impure will ever enter in [Heaven], nor will anyone who does what is shameful or deceitful...”

Thus, we need to work to: a) Detach from current sin; b) Be purified from our own passion; c) Be prepared to meet God so we do not have sins.

Why do we need to do that if Jesus forgave those sins on the Cross?

That is what the purgatory is about. Because God loves us so much, there is a purgatory where we receive the Mercy of God to finally be ready for heaven. But, is there anything that we can do to avoid purgatory? The answer is yes: we can do penance to make reparations for our sins that already were forgiven to avoid purgatory time. It is an incredible grace not a punishment. That is why at confessional the priest gives us a penance even though you already have been forgiven. We need satisfy the negative effect our sins here in this world.
