A letter from your Holy Family priest | "The Lord is my light and my salvation"

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

"The people who walked in darkness have seen a great light." This Sunday we hear again these words of Isaiah from the night of Christmas Eve. Christ is our light. Meditating on him reveals to us what is true, what matters and what doesn't matter, and what the right next step is.

With that, I want to tell you about the next step for me: this June, I will be transferred from Holy Family Parish. I don't yet know where I will be assigned next.

It's not a huge surprise. I knew that, as an associate pastor, my term was for three years, and that I could be moved at the end of that. But I will still be sorry to leave this great community. You have been a tremendous blessing to me. You have helped me to see and to love the face of Christ. You have given me countless examples of trusting in his love, of suffering with grace, and of the beauty of family life with God. Seeing you, serving you for the Lord, and witnessing your love has helped free me up from the darkness of my own plans, my own insecurities, my own ego. In this, the Lord has given me joy.

I look forward to whatever is next, for myself and for the parish. As Psalm 27 says, *"the LORD is my light and my salvation; whom should I fear? The LORD is my life's refuge; of whom should I be afraid?"* May the face of Christ always be our light and our salvation. With him, there is nothing to fear.
