Did you know?

April 23 to 29 is Safe Environment Week in the Archdiocese of Milwaukee. Did you know in 2022, in the Archdiocese of Milwaukee, over 180 Safe Environment Education Sessions were conducted with over 3,800 adults trained in identifying signs of abuse and neglect? In addition, over 7,700 criminal background checks were conducted on clergy, employees, and volunteers, and about 40,000 children were trained in Safe Environment topics. Every year in the Archdiocese of Milwaukee, each parish and school are required to complete a report documenting their compliance with the Safe Environment Program's policies and procedures. The Archdiocese of Milwaukee Safe Environment Office uses those reports to compile an archdiocesan report for USCCB audit firm Stonebridge Partners on our archdiocesan compliance with the Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People. The Archdiocese of Milwaukee has been found compliant every year since 2004.
