Dear Friends,

A Letter from Your Holy Family Priest | "...a promise that reaches into eternity"

As the Lord gathers us to worship at Mass this Sunday, we hear once again of His consoling promise to give to us another Advocate, who is the "Spirit of truth," God the Holy Spirit.

Over and over again in these great Easter weeks, what Christ promised then continues to be brought to fulfilment now, in the life of the whole Church and in our own time and place.

The One who the crowds in Samaria received through the laying on of hands and the prayer of Peter and John is the same Holy Spirit whom so many of our high schoolers received these weeks in the Sacrament of Confirmation, through the laying on of hands, the prayer of the Bishop, the successor of the Apostles, and the anointing with Sacred Chrism in the sign of the Cross.

What Saint Peter names as life in the Spirit is not meant to be lived by our dear Evangelical brothers and sisters alone. It's meant also for us, Catholics, those who by our Baptism share in the life of Christ, having been incorporated into His Body, sealed with the Cross of Confirmation, strengthened by His Most Holy Body and Blood, and restored by His merciful love in Confession.

As I witnessed our high schoolers receive this Sacrament, which is not the completion but rather the further acceptance of the gift of the Holy Spirit, the grace of the Lord, and the adventure of faith, their celebration enkindled memories of my own, as well as that of my siblings and friends.

"Faith is the firm ground for the house of our life; it stands fast even in a future that no one can know in advance. **Thus Confirmation is a promise that reaches into eternity. But before that, it is an appeal to our courage and our bravery, an appeal to dare with Christ to build our life on him in the willingness of faith**, even if other people find that ridiculous or old-fashioned. The way leads into the light. Let us dare to follow it. Let us say Yes." (Pope Benedict XVI).

We entrust them and their families to the Lord, as we do our own Mothers, and our Mother the Church, and pray that strengthened by the Holy Spirit, we might all live for and from the Lord.
