Dear Holy Family Catholic Community Parishioners,

Earlier this year, I shared with you that Archbishop Listecki has called Fr. Edward Sanchez and Fr. Justin Weber to leave our parish and become pastors within the Archdiocese of Milwaukee. They both have made such a positive impact on our parish community, and I understand how difficult this is for us to lose them. While we will of course miss them, we wish them many blessings as they take on this new set of responsibilities.

I'm pleased to share today that soon after their departure, we will receive two new priests to serve our parish! Effective June 20, 2023 we will welcome Fr. Matthew Kirk and Transitional Deacon Kevin Tanel to Fond du Lac.

Fr. Matthew grew up in Nashotah, and attended St. Charles Church in Hartland. While on retreat during his senior year at Arrowhead High School, Fr. Matthew had a moment that changed his life, as he realized for the first time that God was real and present in the Eucharist. His faith deepened as he attended University of Wisconsin-Madison and became involved with St. Paul Catholic Student Center as well as founded a Catholic fraternity, Phi Kappa Theta. After graduating in 2016, he was accepted to St. Francis de Sales Seminary and during his studies, he served at St. Mary's Visitation Church in Elm Grove. Following his ordination to the priesthood last May, he became an associate pastor in West Allis where he will continue to serve until June.

Raised in Mukwonago, Deacon Kevin felt a strong connection to his faith as a child, "playing" Mass with his grandma and his brother. As he grew, his call to serve God did as well and through Adoration, he fully discerned his vocation to become a priest. After graduating from high school, Deacon Kevin went to Loyola University's college seminary and earned a bachelor's in psychology and philosophy. He then entered St. Francis de Sales Seminary and after becoming ordained as a transitional deacon last year, served at St. Francis Borgia in Cedarburg. In just a few weeks, he will be ordained as a priest for the Archdiocese of Milwaukee. When he becomes our associate pastor in June, it will not be Deacon Kevin's first time serving at Holy Family Catholic Community. As you may remember, he served as a seminarian with our parish a few summers ago and we are excited to welcome him back.
