# Stewardship Commission Meeting Minutes for April 13, 2023

Meeting began at 6 p.m. in Holy Family Board Room; prayer was read aloud by those in attendance.

<u>Vision Statement</u>: To be disciples in Christ – living witness to the Good News.

<u>Holy Family Mission Statement</u>: We are a Catholic community empowered through the Holy Spirit to love God and follow Jesus Christ through faith, worship and witness.

## Missionary Fraternity of Mary-Update

- Envelopes were included in April/May packet. So far for fiscal year we have given \$4,182.34. An additional \$1,708 has come in from envelopes to date, with more coming in regularly.
- Future informational video to promote parish support or possible guest speaker also proposed as good way to present mission (Fr. Alejandro?).

## **General Financial Outlook-Update**

- Parish currently has a net surplus in the budget of \$281,923.28 (compared to budget surplus of \$62,396 on 3/31/23). Some of these funds will be utilized for extra projects that are in the works for this fiscal year (i.e., new carpet for parts of Holy Family offices).
- Weekly collection over Easter weekend was approx. \$7,000 over what was projected.

## Catholic Stewardship Appeal 2022-Update

- Holy Family's goal for 2022 was \$217,400; we raised \$246,849.
- Goal for 2023 is set at \$217,400 as well; we have currently raised \$121,136.

## Love One Another Campaign-Update

- Have currently reached 78% of our goal for pledges (\$3,324,894.82) with only about 14% of parish taking part. The 60% that will be available for parish is designated to be spent in three areas:
  - 1) Renovation of interiors and exteriors of building sites.
  - 2) Endowment
  - 3) Evangelization, Communication and Education

- Opportunity to attend informational meeting in Milwaukee to learn fresh ideas and tools for parish stewardship. Meeting will take place from 8:30 a.m.-noon, with mass to follow.

#### Old Business/Reports on Events

- Our Risen Savior (ORS) Fellowship Days:

(March): 70-75 in attendance, expenses of \$92, no collections, leftover food was donated after to Beacon House and shelter at St. VdP.
