Registration to open for Christian Formation program

Registration will open Friday, July 7 online at hffdl.org/cf for our Faith Formation programs. Various programs are open for children to enroll in depending on their age level, including Sacramental Preparation for First Reconciliation, First Communion, and Confirmation. The programs are as follows:

- Yearly Faith Formation: For students entering grades 1-8 in the 2023-2024 school year. Children who attended Summer Program in 2023 or attend Catholic school do not need to sign up for Yearly Faith Formation.
- **High School Faith Formation:** For students entering grades 9-10.
- **First Reconciliation and First Communion Preparation:** For all students entering grades 2-4, both public and Catholic school students. Sacramental Preparation is completed at the parish (not the school) for SMSA students. Public school students should complete the Summer or Yearly Faith Formation Program as well. First Reconciliation is a pre-requisite to First Communion. Public school students entering second grade are automatically registered for the program when registering for Yearly Formation/Summer program.
- Confirmation Preparation: For students entering grades 11 and 12 who will be age 16 at time of Confirmation.
