In the heart of summer, Holy Family Church joyfully prepares to commemorate one of the most significant events in the liturgical calendar, the Feast of Corpus Christi. This special celebration, which falls on the Sunday following the solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, invites the faithful to reflect upon and honor the presence of Christ in the Eucharist.

The Feast of Corpus Christi, also known as the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, serves as a powerful reminder of the incredible gift that Jesus gave to His disciples at the Last Supper. During this momentous occasion, He instituted the sacrament of the Eucharist, transforming bread and wine into His body and blood, allowing us to partake in His eternal sacrifice. Corpus Christi, Latin for "Body of Christ," encapsulates the profound truth that Jesus is truly present in the consecrated elements.

We encourage everyone to join us for Mass this weekend. We also invite you to join us this weekend for our Eucharistic procession at Marian University. The candlelight procession begins at 8:00 pm in the Stayer Center parking lot and will process to Dorcas Chapel where there will be adoration and prayers. The procession will be a public witness to our faith in Christ's real presence. As we march through the streets, we will offer prayers for the needs of our community, seeking God's grace and mercy upon our city and its inhabitants.

As you know, we are also preparing to further make the Eucharist a focal point of our worship by moving our Tabernacle behind the altar at Holy Family Church. Due to supply delays beyond our control, construction for this project has been postponed along with our Tabernacle blessing at the 10:00 am Mass on Sunday, June 18. We greatly appreciate all the work that Capelle Bros. & Diedrich, Inc. has put into this project, and we look forward to sharing the fruits of their labor with you soon.

As we anticipate the Feast of Corpus Christi, let us prepare our hearts to welcome Jesus, truly present among us, with reverence and awe. 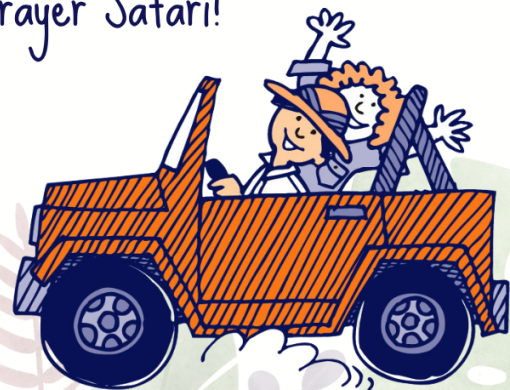
