A Letter from Your Holy Family Priest | "The harvest is abundant"

Praised be Jesus Christ!

On this Father's Day, Our Lord's words resonate deeply here within the Archdiocese of Milwaukee.

"Then he said to his disciples, 'The harvest is abundant but the laborers are few; so ask the master of the harvest to send out laborers for his harvest."

It's a gift to share in the priesthood of the Lord and to be sent as His priest.

Together we "storm Heaven" this week for Father Matthew Kirk and Father Kevin Tanel, who begin their new assignments here this Tuesday, as well as for the continued renewal of our Church, through both marriage and family life, as well as priesthood and religious life.

"Without cost you have received; without cost you are to give." May it be so for us here at Holy Family!
