A Letter from Your Holy Family Priest | The Sanctuary – Sacred Space

The sanctuary is a sacred space, and must be used only for the sacred – the liturgy. The sanctuary is the location of the altar in all churches and of the tabernacle in most. As such, it is considered sacred space and cannot be used in the manner of a simple public space, as secular concerts, or other activities which are not considered part of the liturgy of the Church.



In this context, the Code of Canon Law states: “In a sacred place only those things are to be permitted which serve to exercise or promote worship, piety, and religion. Anything out of harmony with the holiness of the place is forbidden. The ordinary may, however, for individual cases, permit other uses, provided they are not contrary to the sacred character of the place (CIC 1210).” Unfortunately, the sanctuaries in many parishes are used for certain events which are not liturgically acceptable. We should remember that the sanctuary is a place that is sacred, holy, and set apart for the celebration of the Holy Mass.
