A letter from your Holy Family Priest | The Eucharist and the Sacrilege against it

The Eucharist is the sacrament that makes present, in the liturgical celebration of the Holy Church, the person of Jesus Christ (Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity) and his redemptive sacrifice, in the fullness of the Paschal Mystery of his passion, death, and resurrection. This real presence in the Eucharist is active, since Our Lord Jesus Christ makes himself present with the dynamism of his saving love: in the Eucharist. Jesus invites us to welcome the salvation that he offers us and to receive the gift of his Body and Blood as food for eternal life, allowing us to enter into communion with him, and at the same time into communion with all the members of his Mystical Body, which is the Church.

However, we see how many sacrileges are committed against the Eucharist. This sacrilege is typified in the catechism of the Catholic Church and the Code of Canon Law. In the catechism, number 2120 it says: "Sacrilege consists in desecrating or unworthily treating the sacraments and other liturgical actions, as well as persons, things, and places consecrated to God. Sacrilege is a serious sin, especially when it is committed against the Eucharist, since in this sacrament the Body of Christ is substantially made present to us." The Code of Canon Law qualifies sacrilege as a crime: "canon 1367 - Whoever throws consecrated species to the ground, or carries or retains them for a sacrilegious purpose, incurs latae sententiae excommunication reserved to the Apostolic See; the cleric may also be punished with another penalty, not excluding expulsion from the clerical state." And at the same time, it establishes that it must be punished: "1376 - Whoever desecrates a sacred thing, movable or immovable, must be punished with a just penalty."

That is why we must be attentive to the sacrileges that are committed against the Eucharist, to make reparation for those who commit it, and at the same time catechize our people about the greatness and dignity of the Holy Eucharist, who is Jesus himself present.
