This coming week, we celebrate two beautiful feast days in the Church's calendar. On Wednesday, we celebrate the Solemnity of All Saints' Day, followed the next day by the commemoration of the faithful departed, known also as All Souls' Day. In celebrating all the Saints, the Church holds up each man and woman throughout the centuries who has "finished the race," living lives of heroic courage, generosity, and holiness. The glory of the Saints invites us to rejoice in their glory, because that same glory is meant for us. Relatedly, through this solemnity, the Church implores us to beg for their intercession. Each Saint, with the exception of Our Lady, experienced the depths of human weakness including sin, often times grave sin, and yet they gave witness to the power of God's grace and mercy—that God truly can accomplish anything in each soul He has created if we allow him even the slightest opportunity. Perhaps this week is an opportunity to learn more about a Saint and their story, and even more importantly, invite them to pray for you. Consider returning to the Saint whose name you picked at your Confirmation to intercede for you to God, that like them, you might become the Saint God has created you to be.

By way of celebrating this beautiful feast day, please consider coming to adoration at Holy Family this Tuesday into Wednesday. We will begin with exposition of the Blessed Sacrament immediately following the 7:00 pm Mass on Tuesday, October 31, and conclude with benediction just prior to the 7:00 am Mass on Wednesday, November 1. You are welcome to stop in anytime throughout the night and spend some time with Jesus. This is a beautiful opportunity to pray for our Church, world, loved ones both living and deceased, and our own deeper union with the Lord.

Please know of my prayers for you and most especially for your deceased loved ones who we pray for especially this week and throughout the month of November. It is a privilege to be your priest!
