#### A letter from your Holy Family Priest | Remembering Fr. Sippel

Praised be Jesus Christ!

On the heels of Saturday's great Oktoberfest celebration, as we gather to worship the Lord this weekend, we hear often of the vineyard in our readings, one of the images privileged most by all of Sacred Scripture, to speak of the Father's love, and to call us back to lives of fidelity.

Recently, our parish community gathered to mourn, remember, and offer the Mass of Christian Burial for Father Ed Sippel, who died on Wednesday, September 27, 2023, at the age of 101.

As many of us already know, Father Sippel faithfully served as a priest for so many years in the vineyard of the Lord, 76 to be exact, and spent most of them right here in Fond du Lac.

During his comments at the end of Mass, Archbishop Listecki surmised that throughout his priestly ministry, Father Sippel would have offered and prayed the Mass some 25,000 times.

As I knelt before Father's casket during the visitation, I couldn't help but be drawn not only to his outer vestment, which was adorned with the image of a chalice and host, but also to his hands, consecrated on the day of his ordination, June 7, 1947 at our Cathedral in Milwaukee.

From that day forth, the hands of Father Sippel so often were stretched forth in the vineyard, be they to absolve a fellow disciple of their sins in the name of Jesus, to celebrate a child's baptism, to elevate the Holy Eucharist at Mass, to offer that last anointing ... not to mention to garden, to play his favorite instrument, or even, as his obituary reminded us, to mix a Manhattan (or two)!

The Lord calls us back to His appointed vineyard this weekend. Inspired by the faithful witness of Father Sippel, so we also go, with hands outstretched, in prayer and in thanksgiving.

Eternal rest grant unto Father Sippel, O Lord and let perpetual light shine upon him. May he rest in peace. Amen. And may his soul, and all the souls of the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace. Amen.
