A letter from your Holy Family Priest | "His disciples recalled the words of Scripture, 'Zeal for your house will consume me.'" (In 2:17) Dear Friends,

"His disciples recalled the words of Scripture, 'Zeal for your house will consume me." (Jn 2:17) These words recalled by the disciples of the Lord as He drove out from the Temple all that did not belong are more than mere justification for these actions of Jesus, as they call to mind Psalm 69.

When you return home from Mass this weekend, open your Bible to rest in this beautiful prayer.

There within, we hear not only the echoes of the Lord's own Paschal Mystery, His Suffering, Death, Resurrection, and Ascension, but also the experience of our own lives, and the difference made by our living friendship with Christ.

"Do not let the flood waters overwhelm me, nor the deep swallow me, nor the pit close its mouth over me. Answer me, Lord, in your generous love; in your great mercy turn to me. Do not hide your face from your servant; hasten to answer me, for I am in distress." (Ps 69: 16–18)

Like so many of the Psalms, no matter the particular reality or present pain, its last verses draw us back to the Lord. Psalm 69 is no different; it invites us to trust in the coming restoration of God.

"For God will rescue Zion, and rebuild the cities of Judah. They will dwell there and possess it; the descendants of God's servants will inherit it; those who love God's name will dwell in it." (36-37).

We know that God's rescue plan comes not from a faceless committee, but rather with a human face and heart, His only-begotten Son, our Lord Jesus Christ, whom we worship this Lenten weekend!

In less than a month's time, we already will have celebrated Easter Sunday. Before then, many opportunities remain for each one of us to deepen our zeal for the Lord, including the last two Lenten priest talks at Sacred Heart, Stations of the Cross on Fridays at Holy Family and Our Risen Savior, and our Day of Reconciliation on Wednesday, March 20 at Holy Family from 8:00 am to 8:00 pm.

Please know of our prayerful encouragement as together we make our pilgrim way to Easter Sunday!
