*A letter from your Holy Family Priest | Lent and Conversion*

Lent is one of the most important times for Catholics. It is a time given to Christian communities and to every believer to settle their lives, and to be in a deeper conversion. That is why conversion is at the center of the whole liturgy of this period of the year, of the biblical readings, and of the prayers. Conversion is the motive and one of the goal of the Traditional Lenten practices. But we know full well that we cannot return to God unless He Himself makes us return, unless He grants us the grace of the forgiveness of our faults. We hear these efficacious words at the end of sacramental confession by the priest.

To receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation during Lent is traditional in the Church. Lent is an ideal time to discover its meaning anew and to recapture the sound practice Christian life cannot do without. We can say that Lent by its very nature tends toward this genuine repentance. It implies participation in the Sacrament of Reconciliation.
