# A letter from your Holy Family Priest | "... The light of Christ is never completely extinguished."

Dear brothers and sisters in the Lord,

Peace of Christ! As we celebrate this "Laetare" or "Rejoice" Sunday, we are reminded that Lent is about half over, and we are indeed quickly approaching the holiest week of the year. Amidst the many celebrations during Holy Week, the greatest of which is the Sacred Triduum (Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Holy Saturday), we will also be celebrating what is often called "Tenebrae." This ancient tradition, dating back at least 1,000 years, means "darkness," and is marked by its distinctly somber and mournful character. While all three of the Triduum liturgies have consoling pieces to them, Tenebrae is utterly void of consolations, as seen in the progressive extinguishing of candles, symbolizing our Lord being taken away from us and the hopelessness that His death seems to bring. The Tenebrae liturgy invites all of us to walk with our Lord in His agony, passion, and death, and to feel the pain of those first disciples who witnessed Jesus being taken from them. Of course, we know how the story ends, and this Liturgy reminds us that despite the overwhelming darkness of that week, the light of Christ is never completely extinguished. In the end, God always brings His greatest victories out of what appears to be the greatest defeats.

Amidst the many opportunities to enter into Holy Week, consider praying at this ancient and beautiful liturgy. We will celebrate Tenebrae at Our Risen Savior on Wednesday, March 27 at 7:00 pm. Walk with Jesus in His agony and passion and invite Him to shine His light into the darkest parts of your hearts.

Please know of my continued prayers for you and your families. It is a great joy to be your priest.
