Hearing Loop installed at St. Peter

Those with hearing aids can now utilize St. Peter's new Hearing Loop system to better hear the Mass. Installed in memory of Julitta Bertram, the system allows people with hearing aids to turn their hearing aid to "T" or "telecoil setting" and have the sound from the church's sound system transmitted through the loop's wireless signal and into their hearing aid. It is the same system found at Holy Family, Sacred Heart, and St. Mary Churches. We are very grateful for the generous donation that made this project possible.

Did you know?

April 21 to 28 is Safe Environment Week in the Archdiocese of Milwaukee. In 2023, in the Archdiocese of Milwaukee, over 250 Safe Environment Education Sessions were conducted with over 4,400 adults trained in identifying signs of abuse and neglect, over 7,900 criminal background checks were conducted on clergy, employees, and volunteers, and about 40,000 children were trained in Safe Environment topics. Yearly in the Archdiocese of Milwaukee, each parish and school are required to complete a report documenting their compliance with the Safe Environment Program's policies and procedures. The Archdiocese of Milwaukee Safe Environment Office uses those reports to compile an archdiocesan report for USCCB audit firm on our archdiocesan compliance with the Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People. The Archdiocese of Milwaukee has been found compliant every year since 2004.

Dear Brothers & Sisters,

Easter Blessings to all of you! In January, I shared with you that Fr. Michael Malucha will leave us in June to become the Vocation Director for the Archdiocese of Milwaukee. While we will miss Fr. Michael and are deeply grateful for all that he has done to better our faith community both here at Holy Family and at St. Mary's Springs Academy, I write to you today to share good news: Archbishop Listecki has appointed Deacon Kevin Durand to become Holy Family's newest Associate Pastor. In his role at Holy Family, Deacon Kevin will serve our parish as well as serve as the pastor designate to St. Mary's Springs Academy, where he will spend much of his day.

As a child, Deacon Kevin attended St. Thomas Aquinas Parish in Waterford, and today credits his family with helping him to cultivate his vocation through praying the rosary as a family and talking about the beauty of our Catholic Faith. Throughout high school and college, he set his sights on starting a career and one day starting a family of his own all while feeling a call to discern the priesthood. After graduating from college, he began working in sales, but the call to priesthood did not disappear. He decided to set aside time each day to pray and attend daily Mass to help further his discernment and to ask God precisely what He was calling him to do. Through Deacon Kevin's encounters with our Lord in prayer and in the Eucharist, God spoke to Deacon Kevin's heart and told him what he wanted him to do; be a priest in the Catholic Church.

In 2018, Deacon Kevin entered St. Francis de Sales Seminary, and in 2023 was ordained a Transitional Deacon. Throughout his formation in the seminary, Deacon Kevin has served at the Parishes of Holy Trinity & St. Michael in Kewaskum. On May 18, 2024 he will be ordained a priest at the Cathedral of St. John the Evangelist in Milwaukee.

Deacon Kevin is very happy to begin his priestly ministry at Holy Family and St. Mary's Springs Academy. "Over the years in seminary, I've had the privilege to get to know each of the priests currently serving in Fond du Lac, and each of them couldn't speak more highly of your goodness and faith. I look forward to serving you and getting to know you, and will be praying for you. Please keep me in your prayers as I prepare for ordination and beginning my life in Christ's service as a priest," he said.

We are extremely excited to have Deacon Kevin join the faithful team of priests and parish staff who serve Holy Family come June, and, at the start of the new school year, help to guide the students of SMSA as they grow in their faith!
