A Letter from your Holy Family Priest | "... His Sacred Heart beating with love for us always"

Dear brothers and sisters in the Lord,

Praised be Jesus Christ! Last week, we closed out the month dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus—a month in which we recall the great lengths to which our Lord went to reveal His love for you and me. Though June has come to an end, I pray that we continue to recline against His chest, feeling His Sacred Heart beating with love for us always.

I want to use this time as an opportunity to personally invite you to Eucharistic Adoration. It is there that we see His Sacred Heart aflame with an unquenchable love. It is that heart which speaks to ours in the silence. We are so blessed at Holy Family to have the opportunity to go before the Lord every day of the week from 5:00 am until 10:00 pm.
