As pilgrims travel with the Blessed Sacrament on their way to the National Eucharistic Congress, you will have opportunity to take part in this beautiful demonstration of our faith when it arrives at St. Peter Church, N8079 Church Road. Join us for the Rosary, Adoration, and Benediction at 9:00 am at St. Peter. Beginning at 9:30 am, we will process 6.5 miles with the Blessed Sacrament to Holy Family Church, 271 Fourth Street Way, on the Peebles Trail and Prairie Trail. Dear Friends,

Having come to my last weekend at Holy Family, I am overwhelmed by your goodness to me, not only in these last weeks, but also throughout these last two years. On days both joyful and sorrowful, it has been a gift to serve as a priest in our community as well as at the Springs.
