A Letter from your Holy Family Priest | The Eucharistic Revival approaches

As you may have heard, the United States Catholic Church is going through a Eucharistic revival. The goal is to remind people that the Eucharist truly is the body and blood of Jesus Christ. We have done a number of events here at Holy Family aimed at helping believe in the Eucharist—from book reads on the Eucharist, to Advent and Lent talks, to the Parish Mission, to exploring extraordinary Eucharistic miracles through the blessed Carlo Acutis exhibit, to the Eucharistic procession that came through our parish. We are so excited as a community to worship and adore our Lord Jesus Christ in the sacrament of the Eucharist. For the abiding Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist truly is the source and summit of our faith.

From July 17-21, the four corners of the country are coming together in Indianapolis to worship and adore our Lord in the most holy Eucharist at the National Eucharistic Congress. This is an exciting time because this type of meeting has not happened since 1976.

Please join us the night before the Congress begins for a special send-off Mass here at Holy Family Church, Tuesday, July 16 at 9:00 pm. Together we will honor and adore our Lord and pray for the entire country for a revival in belief in the real presence in the Eucharist.
