A Letter from your Holy Family Priest | The Good Shepherd

Dear Parishioners,

My name is Fr. Kevin Durand. I am the newest priest here at Holy Family, having been ordained since only May 18th of this year. It has been a tremendous joy to be here, and I've already begun to feel very much a part of the wonderful community here. Thank you for your warm welcome and your genuine goodness. I grew up in Waterford, WI, and am the oldest of six children. My parents gave us the great gift of faith, and I'm so grateful to them for it. I graduated from Catholic Central High School in Burlington in 2011, and then from Ave Maria University in 2015. After graduation, I worked for a few years in Waukesha before entering St. Francis de Sales Seminary in Milwaukee. I lived the last six years there, while serving at Holy Trinity & St. Michael's in Kewaskum on the weekends. Those six years were a tremendous gift to me, as it was then that God began to form a priestly heart in me. I hope to bring the sense of belonging and joy that I received at St. Francis here to Fond du Lac, and to serve you faithfully as a priest.

In this week's readings, sheep are frequently referenced. Maybe you've heard a group of people dismissed as "sheep" before. It has always struck me as a rather odd insult. What makes a sheep a sheep? Well, famously, a sheep follows a shepherd. When one dismisses another as a "sheep" they mean to say that they follow another stupidly, or without thinking. It is another way of saying someone is easily duped, or fooled into following another's way. Yet this perspective is really rather cynical. Of course, there are bad shepherds – the first reading leaves no doubt about it. Yet the Lord does not dismiss the role of sheep or shepherds as inherently bad. On the contrary, Our Lord calls Himself the Good Shepherd, and He calls His people, "the sheep of his flock." We do not follow an ordinary shepherd. We do not follow a leader who wavers, gets emotional, makes rash decisions, retaliates, or harbors resentment. We follow the Good Shepherd, who refreshes our souls. Cynicism is foreign to Christianity. We have no need of it. We are never led astray by the Lord, for He is the Way, the Truth, and the Life. He is the Good Shepherd.
