Brothers & Sisters,

Last weekend, we were saddened to share that Fr. Pedro Ruiz had received permission from Archbishop ListECKi to permanently leave priestly ministry. To reiterate, this decision was not due to any illegal activity or in relation to minors, but due to personal reasons.

This week, we are blessed to welcome a new member to our priest team, Fr. Edison Santiago Londoño García. Born in Tulua, Colombia, Fr. Santiago grew up with ten brothers and sisters in Sevilla, in a family who planted coffee, avocados, and plantains.

Called to serve the Lord, Fr. Santiago studied philosophy and theology in Cartago, and on December 15, 1986, was ordained into the priesthood in the Diocese of Buga Valle Cagua.

Throughout his ministry, Fr. Santiago has served around the globe. His first experience in the United States came in 1993, when he served at Holy Family Parish in Union City, New Jersey. His ministry also took him to White Plains, New York, where he was a chaplain in the state penitentiary facility and hospital, as well as to Long Island and on missions to Kenya and Ethiopia. He ministered in Colombia also, including in Buga and back in Sevilla.

Through what he describes as the work of the Holy Spirit, Fr. Santiago received permission this past spring to serve in the United States once more and ministered in Sheboygan before being called to our parish.

We are very grateful to have Fr. Santiago join our Priest Team here at Holy Family Catholic Community, and thank the Lord for guiding him to us in our parish’s time of need. Please join me in welcoming Fr. Santiago to our parish! You can send him a message at frlondono@hffdl.org.
