Dear parishioners,

Timing is everything.

I recently had the privilege of celebrating a wedding Mass for my cousin and her now husband. Two things struck me about the timing of that day, the days preceding, and the days following the wedding. First, the ushers worked diligently to make sure everyone was safely in the church before the wedding began, so that the bride would not be seen until she processed down the aisle. There was something significant about not revealing the beauty of the moment too early. Second, my cousin and her husband were going to spend the next week or so – the first week of their marriage – on their honeymoon, prolonging the joy of their wedding day.

Today, we celebrate the Fourth Sunday in Advent, which means Christmas is right around the corner. While we await the Birth of Our Lord with eager anticipation, we also are careful not to celebrate too early. We don’t want to see the bride before she comes down the aisle! Timing is everything.

Similarly, we do not simply celebrate Christmas on December 25 and then remove our Christmas trees the very next day. Rather, the Church extends the celebration of Christmas for eight days, often called the ‘Octave’ of Christmas, where we allow ourselves to bask in the goodness and beauty of the mystery for a whole week, much like a newly married couple does on their honeymoon.

While the culture may make it seem as if Christmas is over on December 26, it is only just beginning! The Church instructs us to wait until the proper time to celebrate, to anticipate the joy with the Advent season of prayer and preparation, and then to remain in the joy of Christmas for a good long while. In fact, we will be in the ‘Christmas season’ until January 12 this year.

This year, let’s take our timing cues from the Church, who knows human nature better than anyone. It is good for us to celebrate, but it is even better when we do so at the proper time, allowing ourselves to be immersed in the mysteries as they happen – in the liturgical “today” of which the Church often speaks. Timing is everything.
