SAINT FRANCIS DE SALES SEMINARY RAISES FUNDS TO ENSURE FUTURE OF PRIESTLY FORMATION

Currently, Saint Francis de Sales Seminary is undergoing its Zeal for the Lord's House Campaign—the seminary's first capital campaign in 179 years. Just 12 years ago, 26 men from two diocese called the seminary home. Currently, 90 men from 11 diocese attend Saint Francis de Sales, with 71 living in Henni Hall, a building which was last renovated nearly 40 years ago. The Zeal for the Lord's House campaign will help to ensure the next 100 years of priestly formation in Wisconsin by addressing critical structural needs and enhancing the campus to accommodate the seminary's significant growth. Renovations will also be made to the seminary's Chapel and Grand Staircase. More than \$58,000,000 has already been donated to the campaign.
