## **Frequently Asked Questions**

### **WHO IS THE WARMING SHELTER FOR?**

Single individuals – both men and women – who are experiencing homelessness and age 18 and older.

### **WHERE IS THE WARMING SHELTER?**

The Holy Family Warming Shelter is located at 73 E. First St., Fond du Lac.

### **WHAT ARE THE WARMING SHELTER'S HOURS?**

5:30 pm to 7:00 am every day from November 1 to April 30. In the event of inclement weather, hours may be extended.

### **WHAT DO GUESTS NEED TO REGISTER AT THE SHELTER?**

Guests can register at the Warming Shelter each night when the shelter opens at 5:30 pm and must be a Fond du Lac County resident, have a valid form of identification, as well as know their Social Security number.

### **HOW MANY PEOPLE CAN STAY AT THE WARMING SHELTER?**

Up to 36 each night.
