Celebrate Jubilee Year of Hope with prayer card

In celebration of the Catholic Church's Jubilee Year of Hope, we will have prayer cards available at each of our church sites for you to take home with you and pray with throughout the year. Please only take one card per family.

Dear Parishioners,

Happy Easter! Over the past several weeks, we have celebrated tens of baptisms, nearly one hundred confirmations, and beginning today more than one hundred First Holy Communions.

These three sacraments are what we call “sacraments of initiation.” These are, if you will, the foundational sacraments upon which the life of grace is built. In baptism, we enter into God’s own family. We move from being merely “creatures” of God to beloved sons and daughters of God. We become co-heirs with Christ to the glory that awaits us in Heaven, and we begin to live that Heavenly relationship of grace already here on earth. We who are baptized begin to live life supernaturally, and we receive an indelible (irremovable) mark.

In Confirmation, similarly, we receive an indelible mark, also called a spiritual “character” by which we are sealed with the gift of the Holy Spirit and deputized to give witness to Christ’s passion, death, and resurrection in our thoughts, words, and deeds.

Sacraments are “visible signs instituted by Christ to impart an invisible grace.” These graces make us into new creations, equipping us to beautifully reflect God’s love in the world. While we live in the world, we experience the difficulty of living out such a supernatural life. For this reason, Christ has given us the sacraments of healing (reconciliation and anointing of the sick) so that we can be reconciled to our Heavenly Father and to one another when we are weak. Similarly, God knows that we need an arena in which to lovingly sacrifice for others. For this reason, Christ instituted the sacraments of service (Marriage and Holy Orders).

Today, however, we focus on the great gift of the Holy Eucharist and our Holy Communion with Christ through the sacrament. Just as in Baptism we are spiritually born, which is analogous to our natural birth, so too in the Eucharist we are spiritually strengthened, fed, and nourished, as we need to be naturally. We Christians, in order to maintain our strength and grow in our love for the giver of all good gifts, need healthy spiritual food. As every parent desires to give their child healthy food, so too does our Heavenly Father desire to give healthy food to His children.

We are not asked by God to be successful, to be accomplished, or to be talented. Rather, we are called to be like little children, dependent upon our parents for nourishment, love, and communion. Today, we are feeding our beloved second graders and First Communicants with the finest banquet there is, with the fare of the wedding feast of the Lamb, the Bread of the Life, the Body and Blood of Christ.
