











# A timeline of our preparations for the upcoming Sacred Heart Church renovations

# By Friday, May 30:

All groups that meet at Sacred Heart Church must go through any items they may have stored there and remove those that they would like to keep. We will dispose of any items not removed by May 30.

May 30 will also be the last date for groups to meet at Sacred Heart.

### Sunday, June 15:

We will celebrate the last Sunday Mass at Sacred Heart prior to the renovation at 11:00 am.

# Monday, June 16:

The Monday and Friday Mass typically held at 12:00 pm at Sacred Heart will move to St. Mary Church, 59 E. Merrill Ave.

### Wednesday, June 18

The Wednesday Mass typically held at 6:00 pm at Sacred Heart will move to Holy Family, 271 Fourth Street Way.

### Friday, June 20

This will be the last day for our Homebound Eucharistic Ministers to pick up Holy Communion at Sacred Heart Church. During renovations, we ask that you receive Communion at Holy Family Church or during Mass.

### Friday, June 20

Adoration in the Sacred Heart Adoration Chapel will end at 10:00 pm Friday night with Benediction.

### Saturday, June 21:

Adoration will begin at 5:00 am at Presentation and take place from 5:00 am to 10:00 pm every day, except during Mass times and funerals.

4:00 pm Saturday Mass at Sacred Heart will now take place at St. Mary.

# Sunday, June 22:

7:00 am Spanish Mass at Sacred Heart will now take place at Presentation.
9:00 and 11:00 am Masses at Sacred Heart will now take place at St. Mary.

## Thursday, June 26

The 6:00 pm Thursday Holy Hour in Spanish and 7:00 pm Holy Hour in English at Sacred Heart will move to Presentation of the Blessed Virgin Mary Church, 705 Michigan Ave.
