At-Home Advent/Lenten Activities

From Pope Francis: "Advent invites us to a commitment to vigilance, looking beyond ourselves, expanding our mind and heart in order to open ourselves up to the needs of people, of brothers and sisters, and to the desire for a new world." - Pope Francis, Angelus, 2018

Planning for Advent: You should be working this on the first Sunday of Advent, when we have the night off of class. Please set aside a bit of time today to prepare your family for Advent. My two recommendations every Advent are (1) make sure you have an Advent wreath and (2) make sure you know when our parish is offering its weekly priest talks.

The Advent Wreath: Light the candle(s) of your family advent wreath each night at dinner. As part of your prayer before dinner, go around the table and share (honestly, from the heart) the things that you are grateful for and the things that

you need prayers for. End this simple ritual by praying the "Bless Us, O Lord" Meal Prayer, an Our Father, or a Hail Mary.

Advent Priest Talks: Holy Family offers priest talks on Wednesday nights during Advent. Please plan to go one of the talks. More information is available on our website or Facebook page.

The **Lenten Season** is a 40-day period of spiritual preparation leading up to Easter, the celebration of Jesus' resurrection. It's a time for penitential practices like prayer, fasting, and almsgiving, encouraging reflection and spiritual growth. By doing this you can attend the 12 hours of reconciliation service (by yourself or with your family). Go to adoration, spend at least 15 minutes to whatever time. (make sure that you sign in by using the iPad and sign in as a guest with your name), Priest Lenten talks, Ash Wednesday, Holy Thursday and Good Friday Services, Way of the Cross and attend Mass regularly.

Parish Mission: We have a committee that searches for a suitable speaker for our Parish Mission every year. We encourage all to come and listen. You will never be disappointed in the speakers.
