Thank you for your generous response to adoration of the Blessed Sacrament!

Adoration hours: 5:00am - 10:00pm daily

The following is a list of guidelines. We hope they will help you to fully enjoy your time with the Lord.

- Once you have signed up on the We Adore Him site, https:// fonddulac.weadorehim.com/, you will receive a welcome email and/or text.
- 2. **Try to arrive 5 minutes before** your hour. This will ensure continual coverage and allows the adorer before you not to worry about coverage for the next hour.
- 3. At your adoration hour, sign in on the kiosk in the narthex area. Click on your name to sign in. It is important to sign in to show that the Blessed Sacrament has not been left alone.

- 4. Before entering the pew, respect our Lord by genuflecting on both knees. For those who cannot, a profound bow is acceptable.
- 5. Help maintain reverence Please, do not talk in the adoration space.

If you need to talk, please exit the adoration area and have a soft conversation in the gathering space. **Silence your cell phone.**Pray silently so not to disturb others.

Pray silently so not to disturb others You may do group prayer if it is prearranged with the adoration coordinator.

- **6. The Blessed Sacrament will be** reposed for Masses and funerals.
- 7. While at adoration for your holy hour you can:
 - Pray in your own words. Let the Lord know what is in your heart.
 - Pray using prayer books or other devotionals. There are prayer materials by the check-in kiosk.
 - Please do not add personal prayer materials to the library unless preapproved by the adoration.
 - You can sit or kneel, whichever is comfortable for you.

8. If you are unable to make it to

your dedicated hour, contact your prayer partner(s) to inform them that you will not be able to make your holy hour and confirm that they will be there.

If no one will be available to adore on your hour, you can request a sub on We Adore Him

https://fonddulac.weadorehim.com/ or get a substitute: family members, fellow adorers and friends often are willing to sub.

9. If the person scheduled after you does not come in:

- Check to see if prayer partners can stay until they arrive.
- Call Elaine Graf at 920-602-0556
- If you have to leave and other adorers cannot stay, please repose the Blessed Sacrament.
- If the Blessed Sacrament is reposed when you arrive, please follow the direction for exposition.

10. The Blessed Sacrament will be reposed for all funerals and Masses.

We know it may be a distraction, but we ask that adorers stay to adore the reposed Blessed Sacrament during your scheduled time.

11. For security purposes the chapel adoration area will be locked from 10:00 pm to 5:00 am.

12. Weather closing guidelines for the Holy Family Adoration chapel:

- If you are registered in the We Adore Him system, you will be notified by email or text.
- If weather warning states that we will be having 10 inches or more of snow or if it is predicted that there will be severe icy conditions, adoration may be closed the day before the storm. All registered adorers will be notified by email or text.
- Unannounced, 6-7 inches of snow or bad ice conditions.
- 25-30 below wind chill
- If you don't feel comfortable going out with conditions less severe than stated above, please notify your prayer partner, notify your coordinator or make arrangements for a substitute.
