REGISTRATION NOW OPEN FOR SPECIAL NEEDS FAITH FORMATION

Registration is now open for our Special Needs Faith Formation program designed for children with intellectual and developmental disabilities. Students will be exposed to simple lessons, prayers, crafts, and experiences that will help them to develop their faith. The program is open to children and teens who are Catholic or wish to become Catholic but cannot attend Holy Family’s Summer Formation or High School Formation Program because the programs do not meet their individual needs. Students and parents who desire to participate more fully in the faith and life of their parish community are invited to participate. The classes will typically meet the first Sunday of the month (October-May) from 9:00 to 9:45 am in Holy Family South Parish Hall, 271 Fourth Street Way. - **High School Faith Formation:** for public school students entering grades 9-10.
