Dear Brothers & Sisters,

As we stand today on the doorstep of the season of Lent, the Church’s exhorts each one of Her children to take heart and resolve to keep the commands of the Lord.

While we know in principle in that any good law is meant for the good of those for whom it is given, it often does not feel like it. Sometimes, we revert to metaphorically kicking and screaming like children denied a chocolate bar at the grocery store checkout. In hindsight, of course, we are grateful to our parents for not letting us indulge in every one of our childish impulses, but in the moment it seems so unreasonable. The same can be said in regards to the Church’s laws.

With that in mind, over the course of the Sundays in Lent and Easter we will offer short but substantive articles relating to some of Christ’s laws. In particular, we will reflect on the Church’s instructions for us relating to some particularly pivotal times in our lives. During Lent, we’ll spend some time with instructions surrounding the Last Rites, Funeral Rites, praying for the dead, Burial Rites, and healthy and holy mourning. During Easter, we will consider the Church’s laws for marriage including what the primary purpose and aim of marriage is, Her teachings on contraception, divorce, the importance of getting married in a Church, and how to move forward when some rupture has occurred.

As King David declares in Psalm 19, “The Law of the Lord is perfect, refreshing the soul. The decree of the Lord is trustworthy, giving wisdom to the simple. The precepts of the Lord are right, rejoicing the heart. The command of the Lord is clear, enlightening the eye.” We hope, then, to offer the refreshment that Christ promises through this article series. Following the Lord’s law entails knowing it and trusting in His goodness as Our Father. As we enter into this Lenten season, let us strive to be numbered among those who are called blessed because they follow the law of the Lord.
