Registration to open for Christian Formation programs this Tuesday, July 7

- **First Reconciliation and First Communion Preparation:** for children entering grades 2-4 who attend Catholic school only. - **High School Faith Formation:** for public school students entering grades 9-10.
- **Confirmation Preparation:** for public and Catholic school students entering grades 11 and 12 who will be age 16 at time of Confirmation.
